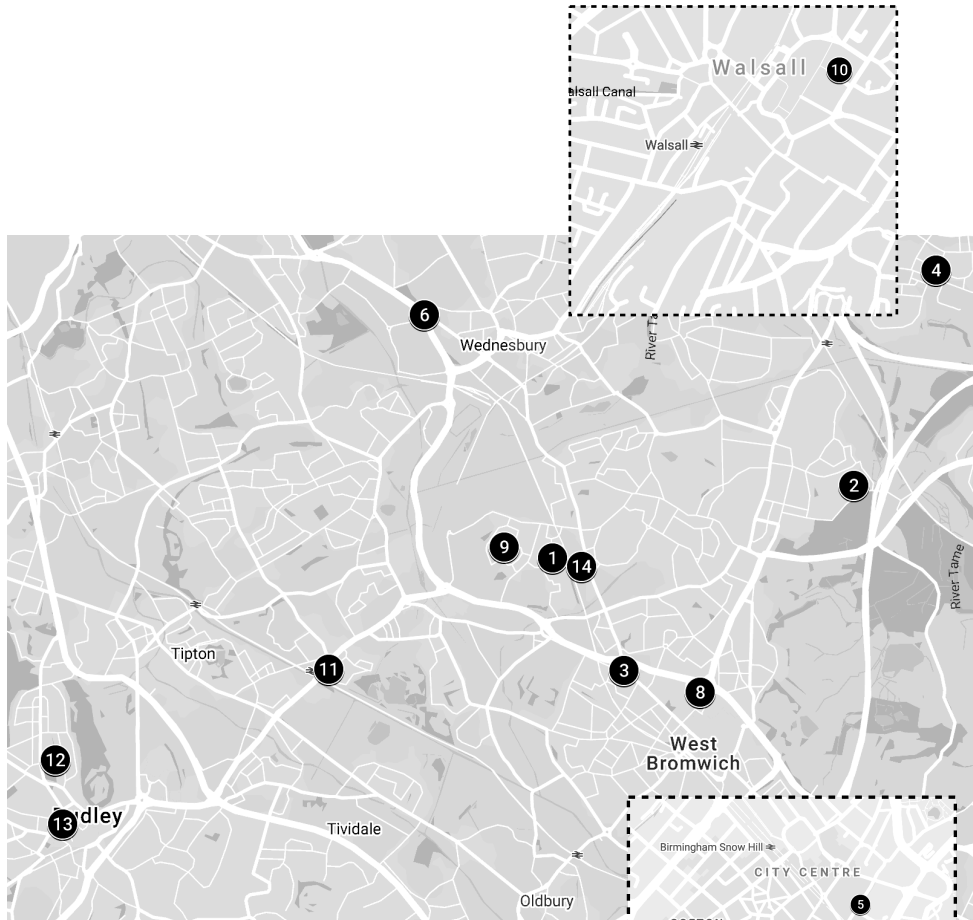
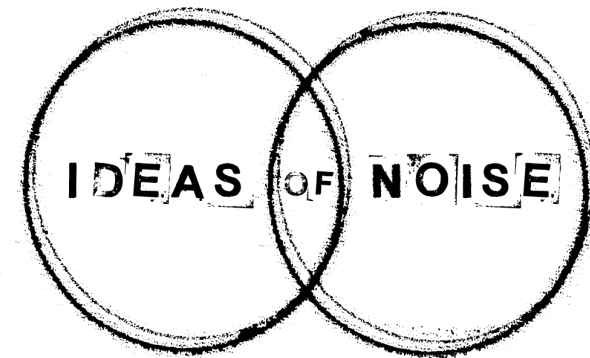

Rather than try to abstract or conceptualise the idea of childhood, I chose to focus on a few every day experiences of my parents, Julie and Chris, who grew up in the Black Country in the 1960s and 70s:

games, aspirations, food, school, work, nights out

The interview took place on 22nd January, after which I listened to the recording quite intensely for a few days - the A2 paper shows some of my transcriptions of and thoughts about a selection of the words.

I wanted to allow the unique Black Country accent influence the improvisation in an organic way purely based on its sound - rhythms, pitches/intervals, inflections/articulation - the stories themselves providing an additional non-musical source of inspiration.

Therefore the notes are not a score that's read during performance, but documentation of a short study, something that was intended to force me to try to access new ideas on my instrument.
